A. Groundwater Monitoring Plan

- Worked on the QA/QC for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter GWMP sampling.

Upon receipt of EPA/NMED comments, modify as required the 2002 Fact Sheet. Consideration is being made to propose to EPA/NMED that the 2002 Fact sheet information be merged with the 2003 Fact sheet (one submittal only)

C. MW71R Pump and Treat System

E. Offsite-Containment System

- Worked on the repair of the chemical feed pump.
- The system ran 96.4 % of the time, and pumped 9,602,400 gallons (average of 220.6 gpm). There were three outages – December  $3^{rd}$  (3.72 hours – a power outage), December 16th (1.83 hours - a power outage), December 18<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> (20.42 hours - a power outage).

The system ran 100.0 % of the time and pumped 2,297,840 gallons (average of 52.7 gpm).
