- Completed the 1st Quarter sampling in the 2nd week of February.
- Began to perform an internal audit of the GWMP in preparation for the 5-year report.

B. Public Involvement Plan

Updated the address lists for the 2003 Fact Sheet submittal.

C. MW71R Pump and Treat System

- Awaiting comments on the Work Plan from the EPA/NMED. Work is proceeding on obtaining permits and on developing project cost estimates.
- Continued to work on the permits as follows:
 - Discharge Permit (DP-1184) ongoing
 - Modification Zoning (Request for Information) ongoing
 - Easement for Pipeline and Approval of Pipeline Design A meeting was held on February 6th with Kevin Currin (City Attorney) and Kevin Broderick (Design Review Committee). It was agreed that the City would issue a license agreement that would cover the design of the line and the required easements.
