**Tasks Completed:**

A. Groundwater Monitoring Plan

- Evaluating Monitoring Wells replacement needs.
- Performed the QA/QC on the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter GWMP sampling.

B. Public Involvement Plan

- Advised by EPA that their comments on the draft combined 2002-2003 Fact Sheet have been transmitted to NMED.

C. MW71R Pump and Treat System

- Continued to work on the permits as follows:
  - a. Zoning Modification (Request for Information) – Received approval on June 7<sup>th</sup>.
  - b. Easement for Pipeline and Approval of Pipeline Design – On June 22<sup>nd</sup> filed the easement licenses at the Courthouse.
  - c. Construction Permits –
- Advised by EPA that their comments on the MW71R Work Plan have been transmitted to NMED.

D. Assessment of Aquifer Restoration

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- E. Offsite-Containment System
  - The system ran 92.71% of the time, and pumped 8,407,700 gallons (average of 202.7 gpm). An outage of 50.77 hours (June 16<sup>th</sup> 06:00am through June 18<sup>th</sup> 08:47am) resulted from a low Aquamag signal. The monitoring system did not activate the phones – testing however did not reveal a problem in the monitoring system.

F. Source Containment System

- The system ran 100.0% of the time and pumped 2,125,370 gallons (average of 50.84 gpm).

    - a. Discharge Permit (DP-1184). Ongoing. Following approval, a water rights application to appropriate groundwater will be obtained. Providing regulatory (EPA/NMED) approval has been received, construction of the remediation measures will proceed.
    - b. Construction Permits – The contractor will acquire these.
