The system ran 99.6% of the time and pumped 9,069,400 gallons (average of 225.4 gpm). The system was out of service on September 18<sup>th</sup> for 58 minutes and September 26<sup>th</sup> for 119 minutes. Both outages resulted from the Aquamag tank running low.

The system ran 100.0% of the time and pumped 2,082,970 gallons (average of 51.8 gpm).
