Tasks Completed:

A. Groundwater Monitoring Plan

- Completed the sampling for the 2nd Quarter GWMP (5/9 through 5/12/05).
- Continued to evaluate Monitoring Wells replacement needs.

B. Public Involvement Plan

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C. Deep Flow Zone System

- Hired a Surveyor to establish the proposed easement meets and bounds. Completed survey by June 2nd.

D. Assessment of Aquifer Restoration

- Continued to work on the 2004 Annual report. The report was distributed, to the EPA & NMED on May 31st.
- Continued with the implementation of the Work-Plan.
- Worked on modifications to the Discharge Permit (DP-1184).

E. Offsite-Containment System (CW1)

- The system ran 99.8% of the time and pumped 9,616,700 gallons (average of 225.3 gpm). Two outages occurred: The first on May 9th for 10 minutes when a successful test of the infiltration shut down system was conducted and the second on May 31st for 79 minutes as a result of low level in the chemical feed system.

F. Source Containment System

- The system ran 100.0% of the time and pumped 2,010,435 gallons (average of 47.0 gpm). The flow is lower than expected - valve settings are to be checked for pumping related issues.
- **The final work plan (as modified) for the source containment system setting out a reduction in the number of ponds being made available for service was distributed April 7th. Approval is needed from the EPA/NMED before work can proceed.**

- Continue to evaluate Monitoring Wells replacement needs.
- Work on the QA/QC for the 2nd Quarter GWMP sampling.

I. Public Involvement Plan

- Work on the preparation of the 2004 Fact sheet.
- Distribute to the public a 3-year combined Fact sheet (following EPA/NMED approval) in lieu of individual Fact sheets for 2002, 2003 and 2004.

J. Deep Flow Zone System

- As outlined in the 2004 Annual report, revise, as necessary, the CW-3 Work-Plan to accommodate the schedule extension needed as a result of issues related to obtaining an easement from the City of Albuquerque (COA).
- Continue with the implementation of the CW-3 Work-Plan.
- Complete acquisition of Easement (access agreement) from COA by June 30th.
- Following easement approval, submit DP-1184 modifications to NMED.
