Tasks Completed:

A. Groundwater Monitoring Plan

- Continued to evaluate Monitoring Wells replacement needs.
- Worked on the 3rd Quarter QA/QC for the GWMP sampling.

C. Deep Flow Zone System

- On September 16th submitted a check to the City of Albuquerque for \$11,300 in payment for an Access Agreement for CW3 pump system.
- Revised the CW-3 Work-Plan (and schedule) to accommodate the time needed to obtain the access agreement from the City of Albuquerque.

D. Assessment of Aquifer Restoration

E. Offsite-Containment System

The system ran 99.7% of the time and pumped 9,358,500 gallons (average of 224.5 gpm). One outage occurred on September 24th for 2.25 hours as a result of a power outage.

F. Source Containment System

- Worked on the backfilling of Ponds 5 and 6 (90% complete).
- The system ran 85.9% of the time and pumped 1,875,590 gallons (average of 44.9 gpm). Three outages occurred:
 - o On September 2nd for 1.7 hours. A high sump level alarm tripped the system the discharge pump needed adjustment.
 - On September 16th for 0.5 hours. A test of a back-up system monitoring device was conducted. This is ongoing.
 - On September 24th through to September 28th hours as a result of a power outage. The call system backup battery also failed and has been replaced.
