The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Sparton (Facility) Technology, Inc.'s Class 1 Permit Modification Request dated October 22, 2008. The Permit Modification was to change the mailing address of the legal owner of the Facility. NMED has accepted the submittal for review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B (2) NMAC. Upon receipt of the payment, NMED will initiate a technical review of the submittal in accordance with 20.4.2.201.B (3) NMAC.

If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.


If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is

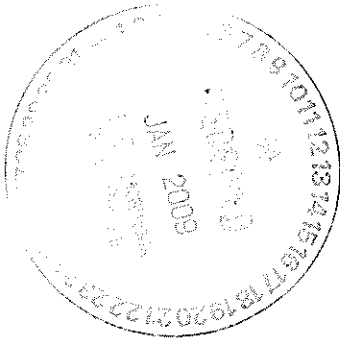
