Tasks Completed:

A. Groundwater Monitoring Plan

- Continued to evaluate Monitoring Wells replacement needs. See Annual Report Paragraph 7-2.
- MW-53 was developed on February 4th following deepening
- MW-53 was sampled (fro 4th quarter 2008) the week of February 17th -23rd.
- 1st quarter GWMP sampling was completed February 17th -23rd.

B. Public Involvement Plan

- Completed the 5-year summary Fact sheet and will submit to EPA-NMED for approval.
- In the process of collecting names and addresses for the affected parties.

C. Deep Flow Zone System

D. Assessment of Aquifer Restoration

- Prepared and mailed (2/2/09) detailed responses for issues raised in the notice of dispute (disapproval of the 2007 Annual Report) and submit to the EPA and NMED.
- Received EPA/NMED Dispute extension notice 2/20/09 and mailed Sparton concurrence 2/23/09. Extension to 4/2/09.
- Pursued approval of the 2007 Annual Report via the dispute notice of 2/2/09.
- Worked on the 2008 Annual Report.

E. Offsite-Containment System

- Worked on the CW-1 software (2/26/08) to resolve an erroneous call back issue.
- The system ran 99.9 % of the time and pumped 8,981,300 gallons (average of 222.8 gpm). There was 1 power outage totaling 1.0 hours on Feb 25th.

F. Source Containment System

- Continuing with the development of a work-plan to achieve clean closure of the pond and sump area.
- The system ran 99.95 % of the time and pumped 1,796,510 gallons (average of 44.57 gpm). There was one power outage on Feb. 17th for 0.33 hours.
