- Continued to evaluate Monitoring Wells replacement needs.
- MW-33 was plugged on July 29th.
- The 2nd quarter semi-annual GWMP report was filed on August 4th.

- Continued to respond to inquiries relating to any Fact Sheet issues.

- Worked on issues relating to location of a proposed new monitoring well. The assigned realtor located a lot (Lot 16, Block 35 of Knolls Paradise Hills neighborhood) and it was presented to EPA/NMED on August 5th for consideration.

- The system ran 100.0% of the time and pumped 10,548,500 gallons (average of 236.3 gpm).

- The four discharge meters on CW-2 were cleaned on July 9th.
- The system ran 96.51% of the time and pumped 2,278,100 gallons (average of 51.0 gpm). There was two outage totaling 26.0 hours
 - One on July 1st for 24.0 hours that was the result of the discharge meters being plugged.
 - The other was on July 9th for 2.0 hours to allow for the cleaning of the discharge meters
