Tasks Completed:

A. Groundwater Monitoring Plan

- Continued to evaluate Monitoring Wells replacement needs.
- Performed well head repairs on August 19th to MW-53 and MW-77.
- Performed the 3rd quarter GWMP sampling from August 10th through August 13th.
- The 2nd quarter semi-annual GWMP report was filed on August 4th.

- Worked on issues relating to location of the proposed new monitoring well. The assigned realtor located a lot (Lot 16, Block 35 of Knolls Paradise Hills neighborhood) and it was presented to EPA/NMED on August 5th for consideration. On August 31st Metric met with Suzanne Busch and Alex Mora of the City of Albuquerque to start the process of obtaining the permit for MW-80.
- On August 12th EPA/NMED agreed upon the location of the down gradient MW-80. The proposed general specifications for the well, based on earlier discussions with EPA/NMED, were sent to EPA/NMED on August 13th. On August 28th EPA/NMED proposed significant revisions to the well specifications; Sparton and its consultants are in the process of reviewing these proposed revisions.

- The system ran 100.0 % of the time and pumped 9,220,600 gallons (average of 221.7 gpm).
