Dear Secretary:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) are requesting a work plan to install sentinel Monitor Well 80 (MW-80). In a phone call to EPA on March 30, 2009 Sparton agreed to install the MW-80 in a location to be agreed to between Sparton, EPA and NMED. Correspondence from Sparton to the EPA and NMED received by NMED on May 8, 2009 also acknowledged Sparton's agreement to install MW-80. Later phone calls between the EPA and NMED have determined the location for MW-80. MW-80 shall have a 40 foot screened interval installed between 4895 and 4935 AMSL. The EPA and NMED are also requiring that a low flow pump be installed in MW-80 for vertical concentration profiling.

As per the Consent Decree Section VI General Provisions paragraph 14 Permits, Sparton will obtain all necessary permits and approvals required for the work to proceed.


In a related matter, NMED and EPA agree with the recommendations of Sparton's "Evaluation of Alternative Systems and Technologies for Aquifer Restoration" report, dated December 3,

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2009. Sparton's proposal to augment the pumping rate at CW-1 from 225 GPM to 300 GPM can be implemented immediately.
