The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) have reviewed the 2010 Annual Report dated June 20, 2011, submitted by S. S. Papadopulos & Associates, Inc. on behalf of Sparton Technology, Inc. (Sparton).

The 2010 Annual Report is approved contingent upon the following modification:

Figure 6.10: The figure for the 2001 TCE Concentration does not represent the concentration data for 2001. Correct the figure.

Sparton shall resubmit the page which requires change in accordance with the modification noted above. This page shall be submitted to the EPA and NMED within 30 days from the receipt of this letter.


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
In addition, Sparton has proposed the plugging and abandonment of MW-58 and MW-61 and the deepening of MW-47 which have been dry or could not be sampled due to insufficient water. This work is approved contingent upon EPA and NMED review of the work plan to perform the task.

Scaling of the pipeline between the source containment well and the treatment plant is proposed as the cause of the reduced pumping rate for the well. Sparton proposes to clean the pipeline in 2011. This work is also approved pending review of the work plan by EPA and NMED. Sparton shall submit a report documenting the improved pumping rate after the completion of the work.
