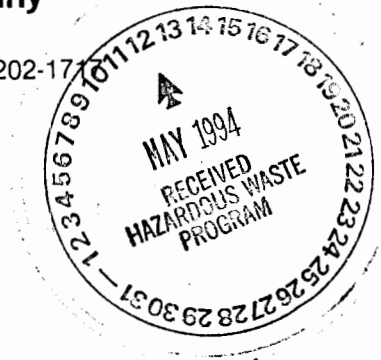

RE: Submittal of Sampling Data Results for the Pit Closure at Compressor Station No. 9, Roswell

Dear Ms. Hoditschek:

As requested by your agency during our meeting on April 8, 1994, enclosed find a sequential history of the sampling results for the surface impoundment closure at Transwestern Pipeline Company's Compressor Station No. 9, Roswell. This information includes all groundwater and soil sampling results, initiating with the December, 1991 METRIC boring investigation and concluding with the last groundwater sampling performed by Brown and Caldwell on October 9, 1993 of the onsite monitoring wells.

Preceding each data set, is a short discussion presenting the date and monitor wells or boreholes sampled and in which zone (i.e. perched aquifer or uppermost aquifer) the sample was collected. In addition, a site map is presented for each data set to show well locations or soil boring sites.
