Dear Mr. Campbell:

This letter serves as notification that TW shall, for all subsequent RCRA sampling events conducted at the Roswell Compressor Station, notify the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (**HRMB**) at least 10 working days prior to any sampling activity. The notification time will allow HRMB the opportunity to split samples and/or oversee field sampling procedures.

All field sampling applicable to the <u>closure</u> of the RCRA surface impoundments must have an HRMB approved sampling and analysis plan (**SAP**). Submittals of SAPs should precede notification of specific sampling dates within a time-frame sufficient for HRMB to review adequately. HRMB will review the SAP and specify any deficiencies. TW shall modify the SAP and resubmit the SAP for HRMB approval.

Submittals of sampling and analysis plans and notification of field sampling dates should be addressed to the Technical Compliance Facility Manager (Teri Davis) with a copy sent to the Permitting Facility Manager (Cornelius Amindyas).
