8-21-98 8:25 am. Phone call from Bill Olson, OCD

He was in Hobbs this week, couldn't get to me sooner. He drove by the Transwestern site, didn't see anything going on.

They are implementing their latest phase, the add delineation work. Had delineated product and now they are chasing the dissolved phase

me - Do you have a compliance order on them?

Bill - no.

me - Are they looking for solvents?

Bill - yes. Solvents, metals, WCC constituents. They finished drilling deep wells either this week or last week. He will split samples with them on the 9<sup>th</sup> of September. They had some delays because they had to work out access agreements w/ state law office. What is HRMB's role?

me - We were working out a consent order with them and then we ran out of atty time (WIPP + fee reqs). We were interested in them investigating source of solvent.

Bill - OCD wants them to do that to. He is hoping they can work something out with the facility.
