
Dear Mr. Spell:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the *Investigation Report Transwestern Compressor Station No. 9*, (Report) dated December 19, 2013 for Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC. It should be noted that four multiphase extraction (MPE) wells were also installed during the implementation of the investigation activities. Appendix C contains the laboratory results for newly installed MPE wells 38, 39, 40, and 41; however, they are not discussed within the Report.
