The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC (Transwestern) second Request for Extension dated April 23, 2019 and received on April 26, 2019. The stated reason for the request is to finalize the 2018 Financial Assurance package revisions and the 2019 Financial Assurance package. An e-mail was sent by Transwestern to NMED on April 17, 2019 that contained draft 2018 financial assurance documents. NMED has determined that Transwestern has met the requirements for the 2018 financial assurance submittal. However, Transwestern must formally submit the responses from the April 17, 2019 e-mail in hard copy so that NMED can formally respond to the comments and include the information in the administrative record.


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NMED does not require Transwestern to resubmit the revised 2018 CFO letter, Corporate Guarantee, and the CPA letter. However, Transwestern must provide the spreadsheets and tables with the revisions from the April 17, 2019 e-mail with the response letter. Transwestern must incorporate the changes made to the draft 2018 submittal in the 2019 financial assurance submittal.

The Permittee requested a 30-Day Extension to May 23, 2019. NMED hereby approves the extension request. The financial assurance submittal must be submitted no later than May 23, 2019.
