The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the *Response to Approval with Modifications Comments Operation, Maintenance, and Monitoring Plan Transwestern Roswell Compressor Station No.9* (Response), dated October 14, 2020, submitted by Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC (the Respondent).

The response to NMED's *Approval with Modifications Comment 2*, item c, states, "Transwestern will sample and analyze MW-10, MW-11, and MW-17 on an annual basis." Attachment A, *Updated Table 4.2-1*, indicates that BTEX samples are collected from wells MW-10, MW-11, and MW-17 on a semiannual basis. NMED agrees with the proposed annual sampling for these wells. Resolve the discrepancy in the 2021 Operation, Maintenance, and Monitoring Plan.
