The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC (the Respondent) letter requesting a 30-day extension to the submittal of the Report of Perched Aquifer Evaluation and Future Corrective Action Recommendations, dated May 26, 2021. The Respondent requests an extension because "[p]ersonnel have been affected and schedules have been disrupted due to current COVID-19 pandemic."


