RE: EPA NOTIFICATION OF REGULATED WASTE ACTIVITY

Dear Mr. Gandy:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit Application for a hazardous waste disposal facility.

The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed your Part A Permit Application. This review was not for Administrative Completeness. During review of the Part A permit application, HRMB determined that you do not have a U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Identification Number. An EPA ID Number is a requirement of all Owners/Operators of hazardous waste facilities.

Enclosed is an EPA Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Booklet for you to complete and return to Ms. Anna Walker, Management Analyst of HRMB for further processing in obtaining your EPA ID Number. Ms. Walker's address is:

The enclosed booklet is designed to help you determine if you are subject to the regulations under RCRA and to help you notify the State and EPA of your activities and get you a U.S. EPA ID Number. RCRA is a Federal Law. If you are regulated but do not comply with the RCRA Notification requirements, you may be subject to civil penalties. If in fact you do fall under these requirements, please fill out one (1) form for each specific site location.
