RE: Request For Review of Disclosure Statements

Dear Mr. Fisher:

Pursuant to the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations, Gandy Marley Inc., submitted a permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for management of hazardous waste. The hazardous waste will be managed at a facility known as the Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility, located 42 miles east of the city of Roswell, New Mexico.


Under the Hazardous Waste Act, Section 74-4-4.7, "every applicant for a permit is required to file a disclosure statement with NMED with the information required by, and on a form developed by the department, in cooperation with the Department of Public Safety, at the same time the applicant files the application for a permit with the Secretary."

I am therefore requesting your Department to prepare and transmit to me an investigative report on the applicant, based in part upon the enclosed disclosure statements. The enclosed disclosure statements include those of Gandy Marley Inc., and other persons who will be or could reasonably be expected to be involved in management activities of the Triassic Park Hazardous Waste Disposal Facility.

I would appreciate it if you could prepare and transmit an investigative report on the applicant to me within ninety (90) days from the date of your receipt of this letter, and the enclosure.
