**SUBJECT:** Triassic Park Hazardous Waste Facility Engineering Design Review



The general approach outlined at the June 5, 1997 meeting by TerraMatrix/Montgomery Watson for performing the engineering design for the subject facility is acceptable. My understanding is following NMED review of and comments on the June 3, 1997 TerraMatrix response to the NMED request for clarification, TerraMatrix will begin detailed design of the facility.

I would emphasize the design calculations and each engineering drawing must be signed and sealed by a professional engineer registered in New Mexico. You will recall, the example project drawing set displayed at the meeting by TerraMatrix did not meet this requirement. The professional engineering seal on the cover sheet of that drawing set attested to the accuracy of the site location map only. Calculation examples were not presented. The level of detail shown on the example drawings is what I would expect to see for the Triassic Park facility.

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
