REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The New Mexico Environment Department is soliciting proposals from qualified firms to provide the following services:

Review of documents submitted in support of Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit Applications submitted to the State of New Mexico. The review process will entail completeness determination of detailed engineering drawings, technical evaluation of engineering drawings, evaluation of responses from the applicant in reference to questions about the engineering drawings, and providing expert testimony at public hearings.

Professional Services may be contracted for up to two (2) years from the date of the contract award with an option to extend the contract for up to a total of four (4) years. Proposals should include the qualifications of all personnel to be used and define what the role of each person will have. Persons providing review of engineering drawings must be New Mexico Registered Professional Engineers in the appropriate engineering discipline.
