Dear Mr. Gandy:

This letter is written to convey to you [Gandy Marley Inc., (GMI)] the New Mexico Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau's (HRMB's) understanding of our meeting of November 17, 1997. HRMB believes that the following agreements were reached at the meeting:

- GMI will submit the Permit Application for the proposed Triassic Park Hazardous Waste Disposal Facility (TPDF) to HRMB by December 15, 1997;
- GMI will submit three hard copies of the subject Permit Application, and one on a 3.5" diskette compatible with Word Perfect 5.2;
- Technical staff will interact and communicate in an informal basis relative to the submittals. No communication unless in formal written form will be valid for action related to the application.

HRMB explained that one of the three copies of the submitted Application will be kept with the Administrative Record for public access; the second copy will be used as HRMB's working copy; and the third copy will be sent to the engineer that will be contracted to review and evaluate the engineering design and drawings of the proposed TPDF that GMI will submit with the subject application by December 15, 1997.
