Carl,

Here is a draft of the WAP. I have had to re-create it from the draft we developed while I was in Santa Fe so it took longer than I expected. The copy I am sending you still needs some corrections. For example, the section numbers are not yet correct nor are the internal references in the document. I am fixing them now and will send you the final when I have completed that. In addition, the document you are receiving does not have the figures in it as I cannot create those here but have to send them to Montgomery Watson to do that.

One thing I want to point out that is different than what we discussed in Santa Fe. The original Table 4-1 which was the analytical methods that were going to be used for the representative analysis sample has been deleted. I did this because some of the methods that were in the table were incorrect and they apparently change more often than I had thought. In it's stead I have added some text detailing how sample preservation, preparation, and analysis will be conducted. I think committing to using the SW-846 guidelines in Chapter 2 should be sufficient for determining which methods will be employed for representative sample analysis. If you think it would be useful I can put the table back in as examples. Let me know.
