Re: Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility Public Information Meeting

Mr. Pullen,

I am requesting that a public information meeting be held here in Caprock, for the community of Caprock and Tatum. I do understand that an information meeting will be scheduled in Roswell and that is fine for the community of Roswell and Chaves County.

Reasons for an information to be held in our community:

- 1) Hardship to drive 120 miles round-trip
- 2) Interruption of evening ranch chores
- 3) Our community is effected and downwind of this proposed facility
- 4) This community is not aware of this proposed facility
- 5) Our Community is closer to the proposed facility than Roswell

I was not aware of this proposed facility until last week when Victor Blair stopped by our ranch to advise us that a permit was going to be approved for the proposed facility. We only live eight (8) miles east of the proposed facility and are directly downwind as all of us are whom live in the communities of Caprock and Tatum.

I have spoken with several ranchers out in the local area and they also knew nothing of this proposed facility and would like to hear some more information regarding it. I have been given permission to use our local community building in Caprock which is located: Highway 380, east of Roswell, ¼ miles east of mile marker 205, then south ¼ miles on Moore Road.

I am also a member of an Association called the Association of Family Community Education (FCE). We have over 50 members just in Lea County and this subject will be number one in educating our community regarding this proposed facility. Having attended Legislative Days we would feel slighted not having an informational meeting here in our community.

My understanding is that your time is very precious and Gandy Marley, Inc. hosts these information meetings. I feel that the health and well being of human life is more precious. I believe that Mr. Gandy lives in Lea County (Tatum/Crossroads), so it only supports that an informational meeting be held in our community and that we are given the time and consideration to understand why a hazardous waste facility is planned for our area.
