

PROPOSED TRIASSIC PARK WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY PERMIT

Dear Ms. Kruse:

I am requesting that there be a Public Hearing on the Triassic Park Waste Management Facility Permit. As a resident of Santa Fe, I am also requesting that you hold an informational meeting about this permit in Santa Fe as well as in the Roswell area.

Finally, I am requesting that there be a 90 day extension of the public comment period and of the date of the Public Hearing. I am having difficulty accessing the draft permit. My computer is a Mac and I cannot access the permit from your website. Frankly, I need hard copy as this is a complex technical document which needs to be viewed and reviewed in detail. Is it possible to obtain a xerox copy at a reasonable price? As a member of the public, I cannot afford to spend hundreds of dollars for a copy but perhaps some arrangement could be made to have it copied at Mailboxes, etc. (5 cents/page) or Kinkos (about 7 cents/page) or even at one of the local environmental groups with a Xerox machine who would do it for cost. I would certainly be able to put a cash bond down with your office while one of your copies was out of the office for Xeroxing. I understand the draft permit is about 1000 pages long so even this would be extremely expensive for me, but I could perhaps arrange to share the copy with others so the expense per person would be reasonable. No matter what, it will take more than another 30 days to obtain and study this document in a systematic way, which is the reason for my extension request.
