

Gandy Marley Inc. (GMI) of Tatum, NM is proposing to construct a hazardous waste management facility approximately 43 miles east of Roswell off Highway 380 in Chaves County. The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has drafted an operating permit for the facility for which it is currently seeking public comment. Wastes that could be disposed at Triassic Park include spent chemicals such as waste solvents, certain wastewater treatment sludges, gas pipeline residues, and petroleum refinery wastes, containing such constituents as lead, mercury, arsenic, benzenes and dichlorodiphenyltrichloroethane (DDT).

GMI invites the public to an informal meeting so that it might become more knowledgeable about the proposed facility and its operating requirements.
