RE: RESCISSION OF PUBLIC NOTICE FOR A PROPOSED HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL PERMIT

Dear Interested Citizen:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is RESCINDING the March 15, 2001 public notice for the draft permit (Draft Permit) for the proposed Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility located in Chaves County, New Mexico. Since the March 15, 2001 public notice, NMED has discovered that an incorrect version of the Draft Permit was disseminated to the public for comment. NMED is withdrawing the public notice of the Draft Permit so that the draft permit may be corrected.

The NMED expects to public notice the revised Draft Permit and its availability for public review and comment on or about June 1, 2001. The practical effect of re-noticing will be to provide a 60-day public comment period for the revised Draft Permit, commencing on the date of the re-notice on or about June 1.

Several comments were received by the NMED from interested citizens during the public notice period that commenced on March 15, 2001 regarding the Draft Permit. NMED will retain those comments until the end of the next comment period, at which time NMED will respond as appropriate. Interested citizens who provided comment may provide additional comment on the revised draft permit.

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
