Subject: Triassic Park - Request for a Hearing

Mr. Porter,

On May 5th you e-mailed NMED requesting a hearing on the Draft Permit for the Triassic Park hazardous waste disposal facility. Your request was simply that and was without any reason or justification. For NMED to seriously consider your request, you must provide all the information stipulated in the Public Notice that was published with the noticing of the Draft Permit. The Public Notice is also posted on the NMED Web page. Link to the Notice by connecting to the Hazardous Waste Bureau/Regulations and Permits/Public Notice.

Below is the relevant portion of the Notice:

All requests for public hearing shall provide: (1) a clear and concise factual statement of the nature and scope of the interest of the person requesting the hearing; (2) the name and address of all persons whom the requester represents; (3) a statement of any objections to the draft permit, including specific references to the permit condition; and (4) a statement of the issues which such persons proposes to raise for consideration at the hearing. Documents in the administrative record need not be re-submitted if expressly referenced by the commentator.
