I am writing to request an extension of the public comment period for the proposed Triassic Park Hazardous Waste Facility until December 31, 2001. The following are the two main reasons I have for making this extension request.

First, I think that the Environment Department should hold another public information meeting in Roswell on this project. The reasons for another meeting include that the first one was so overcrowded that most people in attendance were forced to wait in the hall and could not hear or see the program. It was very poorly conducted and from what I heard it lasted over five hours. Finally, the first meeting was not well publicized in the media. I think more people would want to attend another informational meeting.

The second reason I am requesting an extension to 12/31/01 is timing. The time between now and August 13th is a very busy period for myself and other people that would be interested in writing comments. I am the manager of a state park so the time between Memorial Day and Labor Day is the busiest time of the year for me. I know several other people that are in the same situation. If you grant this extension I will also have more time to research this proposed permit which is quite lengthy.

In conclusion, I request that you can grant an extension on the Triassic Park comment period to December 31, 2001. I also request that you hold another public information meeting in Roswell. The meeting should be well publicized, concise, facilitated, and in a larger building. Thanks for your help. Please get back with me by snail mail, e-mail, or phone before July 16<sup>th</sup> so that I will know when my comments need to be done.
