The following are the "Jim Bonner" issues we discussed earlier. Mr. Bonner and I identified these issues in a private meeting in Roswell on July 17, and Mr. Bonner committed to providing a response.

1. The number and location of the western perimeter alluvial wells.
2. The relationship between the other shallow wells and the clay berm surrounding the landfill and evaporation ponds. Previous figures presented by GMI have shown those wells terminating in the clay material. This would defeat their purpose. Mr. Bonner agreed and suggested that he would look into the issue.
3. Additional information on the Windsor well. It has been suggested that USGS have been using the well to collect

- groundwater quality data, but when I called the USGS they didn't know anything about it.
4. The geologic structure of eastern Chazas County, particularly the Devils Racetrack and Railroad Mountain diabase dikes and their relationship to the NE-SW trending faults located west of the Pecos River.
  5. The dissolution feature at mile-marker 172. I mentioned that there is clearly surface water entering a deep hole in the ground and there will have to be an explanation of the relationship to that process at that location and the possibility of a similar process at the proposed TP location.

Mr. Corky Glenn is raising issues 4 and 5 in telephone conversations and I expect an official written technical comment will come soon.
