**ORDER REGARDING EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT WRITTEN  
COMMENT AND INTENT TO PRESENT TECHNICAL TESTIMONY**

This matter comes before the Secretary of Environment, following numerous requests for extension of the public comment period on the Draft Permit for the Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility (Draft Permit).

Close of the public comment period on the Draft Permit was set for August 14, 2001. A public hearing on the Draft Permit has been scheduled for October 15, 2001. Pursuant 20.4.1.901.A.(6), the time to submit public comment is automatically extended to the close of the public hearing. Many of the requests for extension of the public comment period are based on the need for greater time to review the Draft Permit and prepare for technical involvement. As set forth in the Public Notice regarding the Draft Permit, Notices of Intent to Present Technical Testimony are currently required to be submitted no later than September 15, 2001.

Having considered all the requests for extension of the public comment period, along with the date of the public hearing now set in this matter, and being otherwise fully advised regarding this matter;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

To facilitate the public's ability to participate on the technical issues at the public hearing on the Draft Permit, the date to submit Notices of Intent to Present Technical

Testimony shall be extended for six days. Notices of Intent to Present Technical

Testimony shall be submitted on or before September 21, 2001.

Those wishing to provide a technical written statement without submitting a Notice of Intent to Present Technical Testimony may do so, but such statement shall be filed on or before September 21, 2001.


**ORDER FOR PUBLIC HEARING**
