**Dump delayed in Roswell**

ROSWELL — The Sept. 11 attacks have delayed a long-planned hazardous-waste dump between Tatum and Roswell. The state Environment Department on March 18 granted Gandy Marley Inc. a permit for the Triassic Park dump, which has been in the planning stages for nine years.

But Dale Gandy, president of the Roswell company, told a recent meeting of the Lovington Economic Development Corporation that the permit came too late. "Sept. 11 stopped the waste-cleanup business," he said.

The \$18 million project would receive, treat and store hazardous waste from hundreds of miles around.
