Re: Triassic Park Facility Corrective Action Work Plan

Dear Mr. Kieling,

We are writing on behalf of Gandy-Marley Inc. (GMI) to request an extension for the submittal of the Facility Corrective Action Work Plan (FCAWP) for the Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility. The final RCRA Permit includes a requirement to submit a FCAWP within 180 calendar days of the effective date of the Permit (per Permit sections 1.10 and 10.2).

GMI requests an extension to the compliance schedule for the FCAWP, since construction of the facility has not yet begun, nor is it scheduled at this time. We propose to submit the FCAWP at least 180 days prior to the first receipt of waste. For all other documents and information in the compliance schedule, due dates are determined based on the first receipt of waste at the facility (Permit Table 1-1). Therefore, this submittal date request for the FCAWP is more consistent with the existing compliance schedule.

Thank you for your consideration of our request. We look forward to your response.
