This public notice announces the New Mexico Environment Department's (NMED) receipt from Gandy Marley, Inc. (GMI) of a hazardous waste permit renewal application for the Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility (Triassic Park) and the availability of this application for public review.

Background:

The State of New Mexico is authorized to operate a hazardous waste management program in lieu of the Federal program for the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). Under authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (HWA; Section 74-4-1 et seq., NMSA 1978, (1998 CUM. SUPP.)) and the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC, Revised March 1, 2009), the NMED can approve, approve with conditions, or deny, hazardous waste management permit and closure plan applications, permit modifications, amendments, and reapplications. Pursuant to 20.4.1.901.C(2) NMAC, NMED must notify the public that a major permit application has been submitted to the Agency and that application is available for public review. Under these authorities and obligations, NMED hereby provides public notice of the permit renewal application identified below.

NMED is charged with issuing a permit that will ensure that GMI's hazardous waste operations are properly managed to protect human health and the environment. On March 18, 2002, NMED issued for the first time a hazardous waste permit (Permit) to GMI, hereafter referred to as the "Permittee." The Permit authorizes the Permittee to treat, store, and dispose of hazardous wastes in accordance with the HWA and its associated regulations. It is this Permit that the Permittee proposes to renew with considerable changes. The Permit specifies that it shall be effective for a term of ten years and that the Permittee may request a permit renewal by submitting an application at least 180 days before the Permit's expiration. By submitting the renewal application on October 17, 2011, the Permittee has met this requirement.

The hazardous waste portion of the Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility has not yet been constructed and is proposed to be located in southeastern New Mexico on approximately 480 acres of land in Chaves County. The site is located near US Highway 380 in Sections 17 and 18 of Township 11 South, Range 31 East, approximately 43 miles east of Roswell and 36 miles west of Tatum, NM.
