## **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED FOR TRIASSIC PARK**

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is seeking public comment on a draft hazardous waste permit for the Triassic Park Waste Disposal Facility, located in Chaves County, New Mexico. NMED issued a Public Notice on June 15, 2016, to announce the beginning of a comment period that ended at 5 p.m. on November 18, 2016. NMED is now extending the public comment period until 5 p.m. on January 20, 2017. During this period, the public may comment on the draft Permit and/or request a public hearing.
