Enclosed is a fact sheet regarding the New Mexico Environment Department's (NMED's) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau's (HRMB's) intent to approve Revisions 9 and 10 of the Department of Energy Los Alamos National Laboratory Federal Facility Compliance Order Issued October 4, 1995. Revisions 9 and 10 include additions, deletions, or identification of compliance dates as applicable, treatability group(s), off-site shipment as a treatment option for mixed transuranic waste, and to increase or decrease the volume of a treatability group by greater than 10% of its current volume.

Copies of Revisions 9 and 10 are available for review at the offices of the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau, P.O. Box 26110, 2044A Galisteo Street, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. and at the Santa Fe Public Library between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. If you wish to make comments on the proposed revision, they must be in writing and be received by the NMED Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau at the address mentioned above no later than 5:00 p.m. April 18, 2000.

Final Decision: All comments received on proposed Revisions 9 and 10 made and submitted in writing during the public comment period will be considered in reaching a final approval or denial decision. The NMED will notify each person who submitted a written comment, of any changes made in finalizing the revision.
