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TERMINATION OF TRUST AGREEMENT

Effective December 21, 1999, a Trust Agreement was executed by and between Westinghouse Government Environmental Services Company, LLC, Waste Isolation Division, in its capacity as co-operator of the U.S. Department of Energy's Waste Isolation Pilot Plant Hazardous Waste Facility (the Grantor), and the U.S. Bank Trust National Association (the Trustee).
