Dear Mr. Zappe,
I hear that on July 21 the DOE asked NMED to change the operating permit for WIPP to allow waste drums to be opened, more waste to be stored on the surface, and time limits for surface storage to be eliminated. I OPPOSE these modifications and urge you to DENY the request. These measures would increase risk to WIPP workers, increase the chances that more dangerous wastes would hang out at WIPP aboveground, and put in greater jeopardy the public along transportation routes. I would, of course, rather see production of these awful poisons made illegal altogether. But in the meantime, making storage of them more difficult may cause manufacturers to reconsider whether it's worth the bother to create them in the first place.
