SUBJECT: Amendment to Annual Re-certification of Savannah River Site (SRS)

The purpose of this memorandum is to amend the annual recertification letter issued to the Savannah River Site (SRS) on August 20, 2002 (CBFO:NTP:KWW:VW:02-2790:UFC:5822).

The Environmental Protection Agency approved the SRS nondestructive assay system on October 16, 2002. The CBFO therefore removes the restriction for debris waste shipments that were characterized using this system. SRS may now ship debris waste other than waste stream SR-T001-221F-HET that was assayed with the SRS nondestructive assay system.

All other authority granted on August 20, 2002 remains unchanged. TRU waste characterization, certification, or transportation using new or altered systems or revised or new procedures must be evaluated by the CBFO prior to implementation.
