SUBMITTAL OF THE REVISED 2002 WIPP FACILITY WORK PLAN FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT UNITS AND AREAS OF CONCERN

This notice fulfills requirements contained in Module VII.D.4 of the WIPP Hazardous Waste Facility Permit: "On or before five (5) calendar days prior to the due date of each submittal... required by this Module, the Permittees shall mail a notice to each individual, specified in Permit Condition VII.D.2.a, indicating the date the respective submittal will be made available for public review at the repositories."

As required by the WIPP Hazardous Waste Facility Permit, the DOE will place copies of all completed documents related to corrective action activities in the information repositories. These documents will include correspondence, progress reports, work plans, reports, and other documents deemed appropriate by the NMED. Each document placed in the repository will include the date of submittal to the repository. The documents will be placed in the repositories on or before the date the submittal is due to the NMED.

Written comments concerning the revised 2002 WIPP Facility Work Plan should be forwarded to the NMED representative, at the address provided below, by December 5, 2002.
