Subject: Notice to Generator/Storage Sites


Dear Mr. Lee:

This notice is being issued to inform you that the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) facility has the appropriate Hazardous Waste Facility Permit No. NM4890139088-TSDF issued by the State of New Mexico Environment Department, on November 26, 1999. The state hazardous waste management program has been approved by the US. EPA and Region 6 to operate in lieu of the Federal RCRA program per 40 CFR Part 272. The conditions of the WIPP permit allow the acceptance of transuranic mixed waste that General Electric Vallecitos Nuclear Center is shipping. Waste designated for disposal at the WIPP facility must be characterized in compliance with the applicable provisions in the Permit.

This notice satisfies the WIPP Hazardous Waste Facility Permit condition in Section II.B.2., which states: "Before the Permittees receive TRU-mixed waste from an off-site source for the first time, they shall inform the generator/storage site in writing that they have the appropriate Permits for, and will accept the waste the generator/storage site is shipping. The Permittees shall keep a copy of this written notice as part of the operating record, as required by 20 NMAC 4.1.500 (incorporating 40 CFR §264.12(b))."
