

Block # 16: Acceptance of Proposed Corrective Actions

An evaluation has been performed of the corrective actions detailed in the WTS corrective action plan (CAP) developed in response to CBFO Corrective Action Report (CAR) 10-048. The CAP was submitted via WTS memorandum CP:10:01578, dated September 15, 2010, from Mr. D. K. Ploetz, Manager, Central Characterization Project, to Mr. D. S.
