Hello,

After discussions with NMED and CBFO, and a revised Hanton sertification letter (with which we have separately concurred) we are removing the prohibition on CCPs use of a calculation method to estimate liquid volume during RTR.

We were unaware of the NMED June 2010 permit requirements and believe that NMED's permit is the appropriate mechanism for dealing with this issue. We have agreement between all parties that the RTR operators need to have more training on reporting the results of the estimates, and NMED would prefer that the liquid estimates be rounded up to be conservative. CBFO has committed to training the RTR personnel on this.

In addition, another outcome is that CBFO has committed to developing information on where the hazardous waste permit overlaps or otherwise may affect our waste characterization activities and CBFO, EPA and NMED will participate in a session to go over the areas of potential commonality, and especially capture the recent permit requirements. We will try to coordinate this when we have activities at LANL in the next few months. JR Stroble will lead this effort.

Lastly, after reviewing what has transpired, this was probably more of a communication issue than anything else. It appears to me that if there had been better communication earlier on this topic, then it would not have been an issue. We can discuss this at the February management meeting.

I do not have email addresses for the complete list of people on the distribution list, so I ask JR to send this on to whomever else may need the letter.


