In response to your questions and concerns regarding "State Only Waste Numbers", there is not a specific citation in our dangerous waste regulations (173-303 WAC) that states that waste identified with "State Only Numbers" apply only to the State of Washington. However, this is decision made within the sovereignty of the State of Washington. This may not be the case with other States.
