
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Running Annual Average for Carbon Tetrachloride (ppbv)

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Damage to Well SNL-13 Summary


- Early on February 16, 2012, a tractor trailer hauling equipment struck one of WIPP's monitoring wells (SNL-13).

 - Well repaired the same day and is operational.




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Seismic Event

- On Sunday, March 18th, the US Geological Survey reported a 2.9 magnitude earthquake approximately 23 miles east/southeast of Carlsbad, NM.
- The earthquake had no effect on the WIPP facility.



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Waste Hoist

- March 24th
 - During normal startup of the Waste Hoist, a breaker would not remain closed.
- March 26th
 - Troubleshooting continued and focused on Waste Hoist controls
- March 27th
 - Two transformers were replaced and new fuses installed.
 - The Waste Hoist was returned to service at approximately 6:00 pm.

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Additional Questions

- Will Centralized Characterization Project (CCP) ship Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) waste that was and will be characterized with the High Energy Real-Time Radiograph (RTR) device?
 - Yes, CCP made the first shipment of LANL waste characterized on the High Energy RTR unit on March 30, 2012.
- Have there been any difficulties implementing the revised Permit?
 - No



Additional Questions

- What steps has WIPP taken to support the January 2012 Framework Agreement to remove above-ground Legacy waste at LANL?
 - CBFO and WTS/CCP each have a contributing member on the project's **Integrated Project Team**.
- LANL indicated to NMED that they will have to make about 200 shipments to WIPP in FY 2012 and FY 2013. Can WIPP support this increase in shipments from LANL?
 - Yes, the additional shipments from LANL will be supported.



Additional Questions

- How will this increase in shipments from LANL impact shipments of waste from other generator/storage sites?
 - No impacts are anticipated



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WIPP Action Items from Last Meeting

- DOE HQ EM has set up a guideline to have stakeholders and regulators to participate in the input of the development of EM FY 14 Budget Process. Will WIPP apply this guideline and meet with the stakeholders and regulators on the WIPP project?
 - The CBFO Manager is planning to meet with the City of Carlsbad, NMED and EPA.
- Could WIPP create a performance measure for each generator site?
 - No, performance measures at generator sites are typically driven by compliance orders and agreements with host states.


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

Salt Build-up on Nozzle, 2012





Feb. 23 Nozzle
Failure on A-3




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WIPP DOE OB Direct Penetrating Radiation



**WIPP Quarterly Notes: New Mexico Environment Department
DOE Oversight Bureau**

Projects this Quarter:

1. Exhaust Air Monitoring Project and Preventative Maintenance probe pull.

Exhaust Air Monitoring Project:

Staff collects filters every day, with the Permittees collecting them on the weekends, holidays and at other times when staff is unavailable. These filters are stored at the Bureau office until the following probe pull shows that a representative sample was obtained. These filters are then compiled by month and shipped quarterly to the contract lab.

Results were received from the contract lab for the July through December of 2011. There were some discrepancies in the result package requiring clarification from the lab. Their explanation was received and passed on to the DOE for their input. The DOE found this explanation satisfactory. Staff will proceed with its draft report.

Preventative Maintenance Probe Pull:

The probe pull of February 22 showed that the probe from Skid A-3 failed with 82% occlusion. In the weeks preceding this probe pull, NMED's flow meter on the back-up skid, A-2, had lost its programming, and was thus not providing accurate readings.

It was concluded that during the three weeks between the preventative maintenance probe pull of February 1, and this probe pull, that NMED was unable to obtain a representative sample of the Station A effluent air. However, the flow meters on the Permittee's and CEMRC's legs were operating normally, and these groups did obtain a representative sample.

It was decided that until NMED's flow meter was repaired or replaced, that Station D (in the underground) would serve as the "Back-up".

Direct Penetrating Radiation Project:

Bureau staff collected quarterly DPR voltage readings, implemented DPR program changes adopted Bureau-wide and drafted a data submittal for CY 2011 Q-4.

WOS staff began implementing the DPR program changes previously planned in response to the updated E-PERM[®] System User's Manual and to promote uniformity of data collection and reporting within the Bureau. Staff updated the WOS DPR Sampling and Analysis Plan and procedure accordingly. The implemented changes appear to have little effect on the reported DPR quarterly dose rates.

The draft report entitled, "Direct Penetrating Radiation Monitoring at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant Conducted by NMED/DOE OB for the CY 2011 Q-4" is pending review. Q-4 dose rates were within normal background range.

Ambient Air Project:

The WIPP Oversight Section had five (5) low-volume air samplers in operation during FFY 2012 Q-1. Four (4) air samplers are located at the WIPP site. A quality control sampler is co-located at the Tower Site. A sampler located at the Southeast Control Site is upwind from the WIPP and is considered to provide information about particulates in the ambient background. Bureau staff collected filter samples bi-weekly.

Staff submitted a draft report entitled, "Ambient Air Monitoring at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant Conducted by NMED/DOE OB for CY 2011 Q-2" to DOE for review and comment.

The samples from CY 2011 Q-3 were shipped for analysis. The results were received and staff is drafting a report of the results.

Vegetation:

Results were received for the vegetation samples collected in the previous quarter, and a draft report was submitted on February 23. The Permittees requested the complete data package, as it is available for their review. The Permittees noticed discrepancies similar to those found in the Station A data package. An explanation was requested from the contract lab, and a reply is expected soon.

VOC

The Bureau considers its January and February VOC results received from its contract lab questionable based upon a comparison with the Permittees results for those months. In an effort to validate the results, the Permittees sent the Bureau's sample to their primary and secondary analytical laboratories, obtaining from both results similar to their original values.

As a consequence of the erroneous results provided by the Bureau's analytical laboratory, the Bureau temporarily suspended its VOC sampling program to make arrangements with other testing laboratories. It is critical that all parties have confidence in analytical results obtained from contract laboratories.

- Participated in two conference calls for planning the National Transportation Stakeholders' Forum (NTSF). Meeting will be in Knoxville enabling attendees to the Oak Ridge National Laboratory. Agenda nearly finalized.
- Listened in on telephone interview of Joni Arends, Executive Director of Concerned Citizens for Nuclear Safety. EMNRD WIPP Program's 2011 summer intern, Caitlin O'Grady is continuing her primary project from her internship as her senior thesis for her B.S. in nuclear science. She is interviewing people from all different perspectives that have been involved with NM's nuclear science/industry, and then performing an overall analysis. Ms. O'Grady still had email interviews to complete with Robert J. Halstead, Executive Director of the Nevada Agency for Nuclear Projects and a few other experts from other states.
- Responded to an inquiry from a real estate agent on whether WIPP trucks still go by El Dorado. She thought 599 might have created a bypass to US 285 altogether.
- Participated in conference call for NTSF Ad Hoc Communications Working Group. Ms. Clark and representatives from Colorado and Missouri have been working on implementation of new fact sheet template for federal nuclear materials shipping campaigns. The team developed a crosswalk (or checklist) for what specific information needed to be included in each fact sheet. The working group accepted the crosswalk. Now the team will use that tool to rewrite a fact sheet for a recently initiated shipping campaign.
- Participated in WGA conference calls on updating of WGA WIPP Transportation Safety Program Implementation Guide (Guide) Section 6 – Medical Preparedness

February

- Ms. Clark, Ms. Porter, and Secretary Bemis attended the WIPP Legislative Update Breakfast at the Santa Fe Hotel.
- Ms. Clark & Ms. Porter attended Surplus Plutonium Disposition Supplemental EIS Additional Scoping Meeting at Cities of Gold Hotel, Pojoaque. Meeting was very well attended. There were numerous comments from the public against turning surplus plutonium into MOX fuel. It is seen as an extremely costly process to create inefficient nuclear fuel to be used in one power plant (12 year production life) under purview of the Tennessee Valley Authority. The value of the power produced by the plant will never come close to covering the cost of building the plant. MOX fuel production process creates more nuclear waste than the plutonium represents in its current form. There are many simple and cheap methods of rendering the pits as useless for weapons production, and almost every commenter spoke in favor of such methods. Meeting finished a little past 9 PM. Ms. Clark and Ms. Porter remained another half hour to further discuss the evening with other participants and the meeting facilitator.
- Ms. Clark & Ms. Porter participated in two WGA conference calls. First covered revisions to Medical Preparedness section of the Guide; second covered all pending revisions to the Guide along with DOE's responses to the WGA WIPP Transportation Safety Program Biennial review for 2010.
- Ms. Clark participated in National Transportation Stakeholders' Forum Planning Committee conference call. Subsequently Ms. Clark and Ms. Porter engaged in multiple conversations with personnel at WGA and DOE to discuss revisions to WGA WIPP Transportation Safety Program Implementation Guide.

March

- Spent large portion of a week clearing out Coordinator's office to allow for consolidation of its contents to fit in half the currently occupied space.
- Participated in NTSF Planning Committee conference call. Ms. Clark was selected to present at upcoming meeting on the progress of forum's ad hoc committees since May 2011 NTSF meeting.

- Ms. Clark & Ms. Porter registered to attend National Nuclear Fuel Summit in Carlsbad, first week of April. Secretaries Bemis and Martin both scheduled to present at the conference.
