Dan - attached are the corrected March 2011 Water Level Data. We have corrected this in the 2011 ASER. We performed an extent of conditions and this was the only month that had this problem in the spreadsheet. When we added the H-19 series for this month's quarterly round, the equations in the spreadsheet did not shift with the addition of the extra line, therefore not correctly calculating the freshwater head values. Please forward to Ricardo and if we need to formally submit an errata through cover letter, please let me know.
