Similar to our previous meetings recently, we are expecting to start in the morning and end in the early afternoon. We're trying to gauge how much time we'll need given what we're planning to discuss. As I mentioned previously, the main purpose of this meeting is to talk about DOE's panel closure redesign planned change request and the upcoming rulemaking process/timeline. However, we understand you all have some other topics you would like to touch on while we're there. Here's the list I have so far, given your feedback:

- Shielded containers (dose rate measurements as part of EPA's approval)
- Repository reconfiguration
- NMED's class two permit modification
- WIPP Waste Inventory (capacity for RH & CH)
- Status of culebra and magenta well heads, as well as current monitoring (and any recent changes)

Please let me know if there is anything I've missed or you have additional issues you'd like to add.

Finally, just FYI - we will most likely have six members of the EPA's WIPP team present, along with Jon Edwards, our Division Director. DOE will likely have 8-10 folks there (from CBFO and the LANL inventory team) and NMED will have 2-3 representatives. Aside from you four (Don, Janet, Joni, Scott), do you have an idea if there will be additional members of the public that could possibly attend?
