I oppose high-level nuclear waste at WIPP. NMED should deny the class 2 permit modification that changes the "excluded waste" provision regarding 243 high-level waste tanks and eliminates the required public hearing. WIPP was designated ad a pilot project. It is not permitted to store high-level waste for a reason. It is not designed for such. We cannot open it up to storage from commercial nuclear reactors at the taxpayers expense. Dry cask storage on site is much safer. Remember the terrorist situation? Mobile Chernobyl is not a good idea and WIPP is not suitable or safe for high-level waste from around the country. Hurrying to relocate the waste will only require future relocations.
